## What is Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)?

Household products that can present a hazard to our health and our environment when not properly used, stored, and disposed of, are considered Household Hazardous Waste.

The Redwood County HHW Facility accepts hazardous materials from both Redwood <u>and</u> Renville County residents for <u>NO CHARGE</u>.

#### Transporting HHW

- Keep products in their <u>original</u> containers
- Do not mix products
- Make sure lids are sealed tightly
- Label materials if original label is missing or unreadable
- Keep flammables out of direct sunlight and away from sources of heat, spark, flame, or ignition
